Who is it for?

- Coaches who are preparing for an ICF certification at the ACC level. The program meets ICF mentoring requirements for certification.
- Coaches who have met ICF requirements for certification but would like to build competence, confidence and accountability while accumulating client hours
- Coaches who are **working to renew** their ICF certification at the ACC level.

What is offered?

- **Seven group sessions** of 1.10 hours each (this includes a buffer so that if you need to miss a session due to illness or a scheduling conflict, you are still able to earn the required number of hours). The group will be capped at ten participants.
- **Two one-on-one mentoring sessions** of 90 minutes each (for 3 hours total). You will receive written feedback and oral debrief on *two* recorded coaching sessions (recordings of up to 60 minutes each).

***BONUS: Two mentors will be conducting the individual sessions, Rekha Hatkanagalekar, MCC, EMCC, and myself (see bios on next page). You will schedule one individual session with each of us to receive individualized feedback from two experienced coaches.
